## RSIPF and RAPPP bosses visit Buala Police Station in Isabel Province

As part of the general review on the police infrastructure in the provinces. Commissioner of the Royal Solomon Island Police Force (RSIPF) Mr Mostyn Mangau and Royal Solomon Island Police Force (RSIPF) and Australian Federal Police (AFP) Policing Partnership Program (RAPPP) Commander, Paul Osborne has visited Buala Police Station on 19 October 2021.

Commissioner RSIPF and Commander RAPPP met with the Provincial Police Commander (PPC) Isabel Province and staff to provide important updates about budget administrative matters. Planning for the upcoming Pacific Games in 2023 and discussing general crime trends in Isabel Province.
