If you are planning to catch up with friends and family this weekend, or travel to traditional holiday destinations, police are urging you to be vigilant during this Easter season.

Police Officers will be visible in our communities and on the roads. This is to make sure people are aware of the requirements that everyone needs to stay at their current place of residence, especially those in Honiara and part of Guadalcanal.

Officers will deploy to different locations in Honiara City and Guadalcanal province. The primary focus will be on reminding our good people of the Covid-19 safety measure and practices. This also includes drink and drive safety messages.

Travelling to and from town is a risk of spreading Covid-19. Driving under the influence of liquor will also put you and the passengers at danger. So be careful when you are behind the wheel.

Police will keep educating our people and those who do not listen and comply with those measures in place; police will arrest and deal with them.
