Police re-arrest four suspects for murder incident in Honiara

Officers of the Royal Solomon Islands Police Force (RSIPF) at Central Police Station rearrested four suspects in relation to a murder incident at Vara Creek recently.

Provincial Police Commander (PPC) Central Police, Chief Superintendent Jimson Robo said the four suspects arrested previously for grievous harm incident after medical authorities pronounced the death of a 53-year-old male person, police have to re-arrest the four suspects and deal with them.

Chief Superintendent Robo said the suspects were charged with murder contrary to section 200 of the Penal Code and currently remanded at Rove Correctional Services Solomon Islands while investigation continue on in to the matter.

PPC Robo expressed his condolences to the family and relatives for the loss of their loved one during this dark moment and appealed to those who might have information to come forward with information and assist police with investigation.

The suspects will appear in Honiara Central Magistrates' Court on 26 August 2022.
